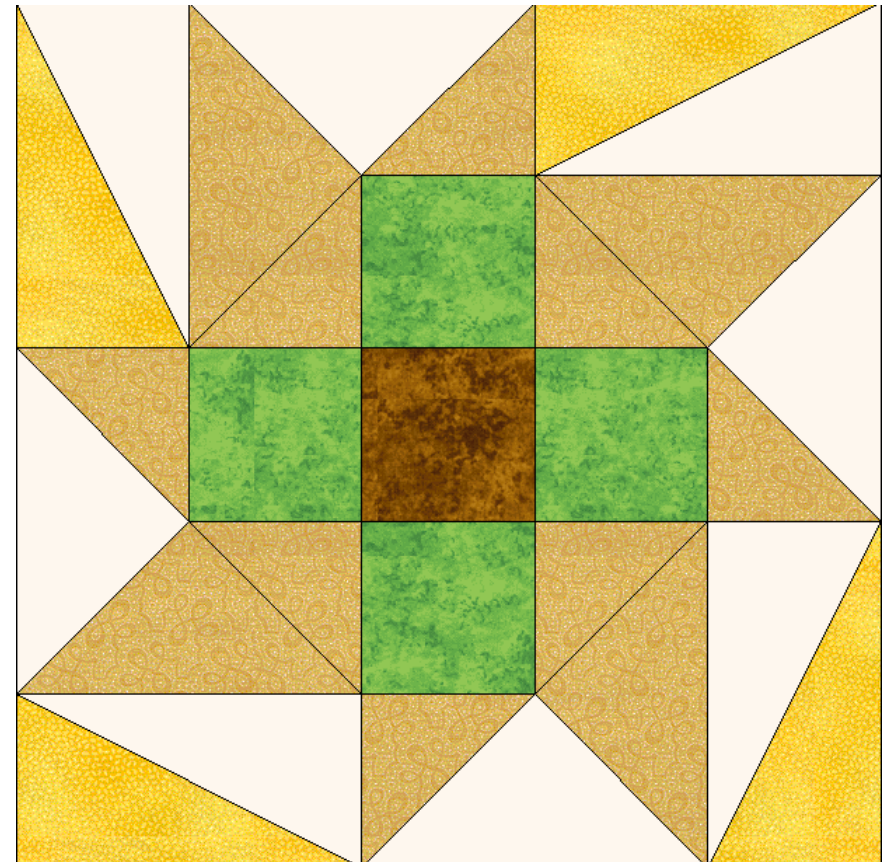

GENERAL DIRECTIONS:

1. All seams are 1/4 throughout.
2. Press seams toward darker fabric after each step.
3. Use either the full size templates to cut out the patches, or the rotary cutting instructions.
4. Use the template diagrams for piecing each of the blocks together.
5. Follow finished block diagrams for color placement of patches.

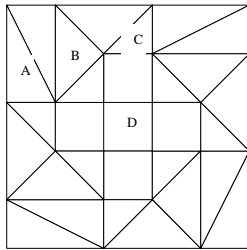
TEMPLATES:

Trace your templates on to poster board or template plastic before cutting, or use the optional acrylic templates available. Be sure to mark the Block letter and the Template letter on each Template.

Template Cutting Directions:

Finished size is 10 inches. You need 2 complete blocks. Cut the following number of patches:

A	Color 5	8
A	Color 2	8
B	Color 2	8
B	Color 3	8
C	Color 3	16
D	Color 4	8
D	Color 1	2



Rotary Cutting Directions:

A – From Color 1 and Color 2, cut 4 rectangles 5-1/4 x 2-5/8. Cut in half diagonally making 8 patches from each color.

B– From Color 2 and Color 3, cut 2 squares 5-1/4 inches. Cut in quarters diagonally making 8 patches from each color.

C– From Color 3 cut 8 squares 2-7/8 inches. Cut in half diagonally making 16 patches.

D – From Color 1 cut 2 squares 2-1/2 inches. From Color 4 cut 8 squares 2-1/2 inches.

Sewing Directions: For each block:

Step 1: Sew dark yellow half rectangles (A) to beige half rectangles (A). Make 4 units (fig 1). Sew dark gold and beige triangles together (B). Make 4 units. Sew dark gold triangles (C) to green squares (D). Make 4 units (fig 2). Sew triangle together making 4 units. Sew triangle units to rectangle units (fig 3). Make 4 units.

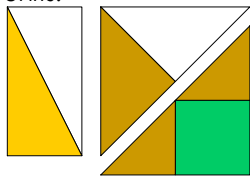

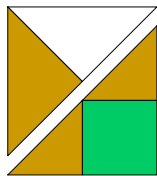

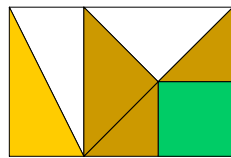

Step 2: On the WRONG side of center block (D), mark 1/4 inch seams with a quilt marking pencil. This will give the starting and stopping points to inset the block. Layout units to form block (fig 4). Beginning with the first unit, sew to center block between seam markings (fig 5).

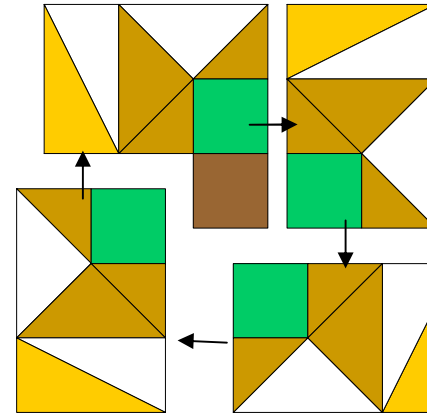

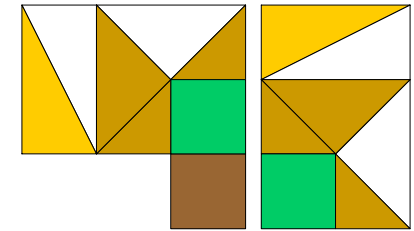

Step 3: Sew second unit to the center block unit (fig 6). Add the next two units the same way (fig 6 & 7). Finish the beginning seam to complete block

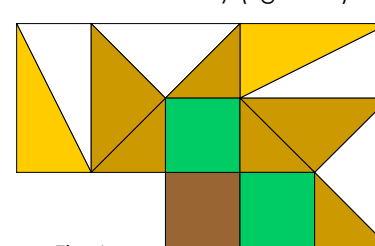

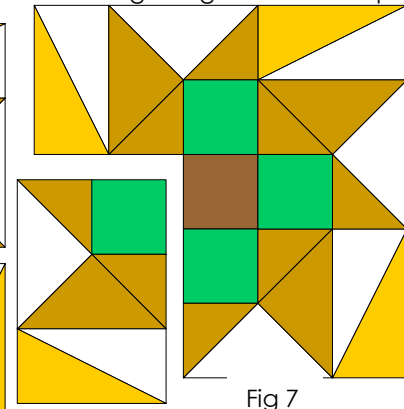

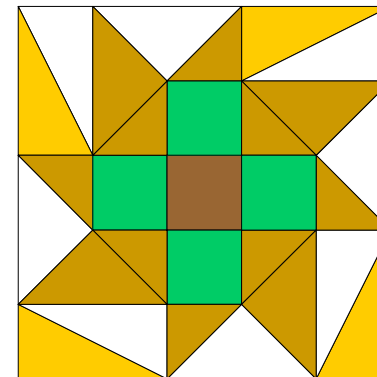
